


Research shows that play is the most natural vehicle for childhood learning. At NDLCP we focus on creating a play-based environment for our students.



We are proud to offer a program based on the educational tradition of the Sisters of Notre Dame.

Notre Dame Learning Center Preschool provides Catholic child care and educational programs, assisting each child in experiencing what it means to be a child of God.

Located near the provincial center for the Sisters of Notre Dame in California, our indoor/outdoor classroom offers ample space for children to interact freely with each other and their environment. Children between the ages of 2.9 and 5 years old are eligible to attend. We assist with potty training at no additional charge.

Since young children learn through play, we give our students opportunities for structured and unstructured activities which empower them to become life-long learners. A typical day at Notre Dame Learning Center Preschool looks like this:

7:30 am early drop-off

8:30 - 11:30 am

morning preschool - including circle time and center activities, snack, story and music time

11:30 am - 6:00 pm

extended child care - including lunch, patio and playground activities, afternoon nap, story and music time, quiet play and clean-up
